## Fraternal Order of Police

### **Pheasant Hunt Rules:**

- 1 member of every hunting team must attend the rules meeting or every member of a hunting team has the opportunity to read the rules and check off when they register for the hunt. (This would replace driving to Benson and sitting through the reading of the rules on the hunt morning @8:00)
- Participants must be registered prior to hunting
- Hunters must hunt in Lodge 23 area (Chippewa, Douglas, Swift, Pope, Stevens Big Stone, Lac Qui Parle, Kandiyohi, Renville, Traverse, and Grant Counties)
- Quill must be fully intact – entire bird must be brought into tail registration table
- Hunter will pull quill from the bird in presence of committee member
- Measuring committee decisions will be final
- Quill must stand on its own, NO broken feathers will be accepted
- Max of 2 quills per bird
- 1 bird registered per hunter
- No exotics or pen raised roosters
- Rooster must be shot the day of the hunt
- Must obey all state laws
- Rules meeting at 8:00 am
- Hunting from 9:00 – Measuring Deadline (18:15 hours)
- Non-Fop Member/hunter must be sponsored & accompanied by a FOP member
- Measuring ends at 18:15 hours

### **Banquet Rules:**

- Banquet to begin at 1900 hours
- A proxy can be named in a registered hunter's absence for the door prizes
- Closing of silent auction will be announced and given a time limit
